I am writing you this personal note to advise you of the significant opposition to the Anchorage proposal within the Hudson River. I know that you are hearing from many residents of Westchester who share a passion for our Hudson River. The extent of the opposition is very strong. We're concerned about the impact the proposal will have on waterfront revitalization along the river towns in Westchester. We also worry about the impact this proposal will have on recreation, the scenic and aesthetic assets of our waterfront including the Palisades and direct hazards to recreational boaters. We worry about fuel spills polluting the water.

I have introduced a resolution before the Greenburgh Town Board opposing the Anchorage proposal. The resolution should be approved at our next Town Board meeting. I hope that you will give this matter your personal attention and that you will help our communities preserve our great asset: the Hudson River.
